

Navigation



A navigation helps [visitors](#) to easily find content on a [Web site](#). Typical navigation elements include a [menu bar](#) on top of a page, an index on the left side of a page, or a [sitemap](#). Search engines use navigational structures for indexing web site content. However, it is often too complicated to [crawl](#) and index [JavaScript](#) or [Flash](#)-based navigation structures. Therefore, the use of a [XML](#) sitemap or [HTML](#) based elements on the [Web page](#) is recommended.
